



Delivering your own RentSmart Certificate (RSC) course

A roadmap for Community Educators

Once you've completed the RentSmart Educator Training, you're ready to bring the program to your community.

Use this guide to prepare, access materials, and design a course that meets the needs of your groups and individuals.

1. Access Your Core Materials

These are the foundation of your course and ensure consistent, accurate delivery.

- **Educator Manual** – Download as soon as you're enrolled to familiarize yourself with the curriculum and facilitation tips.
- **Participant Manual** – Download after completing training to share with your learners as their key reference and workbook.
- **PowerPoint Slides** – Download after completing training to guide each session. Slides include all content and activity options.
All files are digital PDFs or PowerPoints with internal links and can be printed if desired.

2. Explore Supplementary Resources

Extra tools help you create engaging, interactive sessions.

- **Activity Resources** (cards, printables, scenarios) bring concepts to life.
- **Appendices** (sample tenancy agreements, notices, budgets) connect learning to real-world housing situations.

Access these through the **Educator Resources** tile on the Dashboard or the **Curriculum – Supplementary Resources** menu on the RentSmart site.

3. Adapt to Your Audience

Every group is different. Customizing activities builds trust and supports adult and trauma-informed learning.

- Slide notes identify **optional activities** and variations.
- You may omit, swap, or add activities that meet the same objectives.

4. Plan Your Delivery Schedule

A thoughtful schedule supports learning, reflection, and participant well-being.

- RentSmart is designed for **in-person delivery**.
- Each module takes roughly **1 hour**; six modules are best delivered over **multiple sessions** (e.g., 3 sessions of 2 modules or 6 weekly sessions).
- Aim to complete all modules within **three weeks** for continuity and retention.
